Special Event Updates - Fr. Jim Wehner (Rector/President):

- Chancellors Dinner: Honorees are Archbishop Alfred Hughes (Archbishop Emeritus of New Orleans), and John Georges (Owner of the Advocate).
- \$250,000 endowment for Catholic Orthodox relations, beginning with speaker series.

- Alumni Association Updates - Fr. Matthew Graham (President):

- Diocesan Reps/Class Reps
 - Idea was supported. No definitive plan for execution.
- · Question of moving assembly away from Mardi Gras
 - Consideration to move to the beginning or ordinary time
 - Fr. Jim noted 2013 survey that delivered 50/50 split on this issue.
 - Suggestion to set a recurring date that does not move.
 - Question tabled.
- Fr. Jim raised possibility of Diocesan Alumni gatherings.
 - Proposal supported. No definitive plan for execution.

- Rector/President Report (Fr. Jim Wehner):

- 60% enrollment increase since 2013.
- 22 Dioceses/Religious Communities.
- NDS capacity = 150 Seminarians.
- Benson House renovation will house 24 additional seminarians bring capacity to 174.
- 1% increase in tuition, keeping NDS in the mid-range at \$35,000 tuition.
- 3% increase for faculty salaries.
