Grade Remediation Policy

If a failing grade in a course is due to poor performance on one particular assignment or test, the professor may allow an equivalent assignment or test to be repeated within six weeks of the end of the semester. Since the seminarian or student *has already failed the course*, the intention of this policy is to allow for remediation of that failing grade without having to retake the entire course. However, it is not the intention of this policy to expunge that initial failure, since the seminarian or student is responsible for the failure on that original assignment. Consequently, on the condition that the performance on the assigned makeup work is exemplary, the grade for the course can be changed, according to the discretion of the professor, to a passing grade (no higher than a “C”) which takes into account the original failing status and the need for remediation.
