As required for entrance into the Discipleship Stage, the applicant has been able to reflect on his personal history (e.g., family of origin, use of technology, personal habits) and his needed areas of growth; demonstrates the requisite relational skills (e.g., capacity for healthy and deep friendships, basic social skills and good manners, flexibility, adaptability, a basic capacity for empathy); demonstrates the requisite level of self-discipline (e.g., capacity for hard work, awareness of the appropriate use of time, basic self-control); demonstrates the requisite trust in formation (e.g., openness to correction, awareness of the importance of transparency in formation, growing sense of accountability); demonstrates the requisite healthy habits of self-care (e.g., beginning an exercise regimen, good personal hygiene, beginning to address any healthy concerns or unhealthy habits). Applicant is a person who prays regularly; is active in parish life, participates in the Sunday Eucharist and regularly receives the Sacrament of Penance; is drawn to explore and deepen his spiritual life and share it with others. For entrance into the Discipleship Stage, the applicant demonstrates the requisite growth in prayer and the spiritual life (e.g., elementary discipline in public and private prayer, interest in and attention to spiritual direction, understanding of the importance of silence, and a growing habit of silence); demonstrates the requisite growth in an understanding of the celibate life (e.g., ability to articulate the Church's understanding of the promise of celibacy and the spiritual motivation for celibacy, growth in the virtue of chastity, and growth in the habit of healthy solitude); demonstrates the requisite growth in the understanding of the priestly vocation; demonstrates the requisite growth in the ability to articulate a relationship with Jesus Christ; demonstrates the requisite growth in reading and meditating on Sacred Scripture.

For entrance into the Discipleship Stage, the applicant demonstrates the requisite initial understanding of Christian doctrine and anthropology; demonstrates the requisite initial familiarity of the Bible and its various parts; demonstrates the requisite basic habits of study, signs of intellectual curiosity, and love of learning; demonstrates the requisite level of general education.
